






















Summer Term Class Griffin - Homework Grid

Please remember to read at home with your child and practice any spellings and times tables (2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 10). In addition, please choose one piece of homework each week to complete. Make sure you choose homework from different sections of the grid and hand one piece in each Monday.

<p>Language, Literacy and Communication</p> 	<p>Read a Welsh myth from the Mabinigion and write a description of the main character. Maybe adding an image too.</p> 	<p>Write a series of sentences including dialogue describing something about Wales. Remember the punctuation (speech marks, commas, question marks etc...) and a new line for each new person who speaks.</p> 
<p>Cymraeg</p> 	<p>Improve your Welsh vocabulary by visiting the Campau Cosmig app.</p> 	<p>Use the Hapus app to practise talking in the past tense and about yourselves and interests in Welsh.</p> 
<p>Expressive Arts</p> 	<p>Can you make a model of a castle using recyclable items? Or paint a picture of a Welsh castle.</p> 	<p>Can you create a picture of a dragon this could be in paint, collage, mixed media, on the computer or pencil.</p> 
<p>Science and Technology</p> 	<p>Can you find out about an insect and draw and label their life cycle. Writing about each stage of its development.</p> 	<p>Use your IT skills to make a promotional leaflet about Powys Castle for the National Trust.</p> 

<p>Mathematics and Numeracy</p> 	<p>Practice telling the time (O'clock, half past, quarter to/past and the 5-minute intervals). Try the following web links. Telling the Time - Mathsframe Match the Times – 5-11-year-olds - Topmarks Splashlearn</p>	<p>Collect some data either from your family or made up and create a table and block graph of the results. Then add some questions about the graph for your friends to answer.</p>
<p>Humanities</p> 	<p>Can you design your own village and add features and a key explaining these features. Maybe you could add a grid so that you could include coordinates to find places on your map.</p> 	<p>Write a description of a castle including lots of detail about its location, features, what it is made of, turrets, gates, moat etc. This could be in the form of a non-chronological report, a fantasy description, or a PowerPoint presentation.</p> 
<p>Health and Wellbeing</p> 	<p>Can you follow a traditional Welsh recipe, making a list of instructions and taking images for your recipe to share with the class.</p> 	<p><u>Create a Family Tree.</u> You will need to ask different family members to help you with it. See how far back you can go.</p> 

If you have any creative ideas of your own which you would like to do one week instead of doing one of the projects that's fine. Any word processing, photos, PPTs or other ICT based learning needs to be uploaded onto your Hwb folder.
