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Fibre Update - do it for Berriew – From Berriew Community Council

Berriew is one of just two exchange areas in the whole of Montgomeryshire which are currently part of the Gigabit Voucher Scheme. 17 areas are not even being considered and will probably have to wait until new funding schemes are announced.

This means that we are effectively next in line to have a fibre network built if reach the magic number of 138 premises registered by the end of March. If we don't, we go to the back of the queue.

We need just a few more pledges and even if you don't see the need at the moment, five years down the line, who knows? And why not pledge just to do Berriew a service. There is nothing to lose. OpenReach are exceedingly unlikely to come after you if you don't take a fibre product after you pledge, and in any case, fibre services are likely to be no more expensive than your current tariff and much faster and more reliable.

So please pledge. Just 30 more are needed to get Berriew over the line. And if you have already done so, ask a friend of neighbour to do the same. Thank you.
