<p><b>Cymraeg</b></p> 	<p>Can you listen to a Welsh song? Maybe see if you can learn the words.</p>  <p><a href="#">Cân y Fferm   Welsh Farm Children's Kids Song Nursery Rhymes S+C</a></p>	<p>Can you name some farm animals in Welsh?</p> 
<p><b>Expressive Arts</b></p> 	<p>Can you make your own animal puppet? Maybe you could create a puppet show.</p> 	<p>Can you make a miniature farm using recycling from your house?</p> 
<p><b>Science and Technology</b></p> 	<p>Can you use JIT5 on Hwb to make a farm picture?</p> 	<p>Can you research a farm animal and record some facts that you find?</p> 
<p><b>Mathematics and Numeracy</b></p> 	<p>Cut some fruit in half and quarters. Discuss what a half is and a quarter (half of a half/ four equal parts etc)</p> 	<p>Measure out some ingredients and help with a family meal. Which is heavier? Lighter? More than 30g or 500g?</p> 

<p><b>Humanities</b></p> 	<p>Keep some food packaging and see where that food has come from. Did it start its journey in another country?</p> 	<p>Can you find a farm on Google Earth? How far away from your house is that farm?</p> 
<p><b>Health and Wellbeing</b></p> 	<p>Do whatever makes you happy! This could be playing in the garden, doing some colouring or just spending time with family, as long as you're happy!</p> 	<p>Make a fruit kebab!</p>
