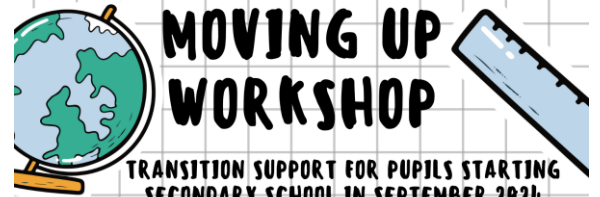



Auditions for 'Oliver!'

Newtown Musical Theatre Company will be performing Lionel Bart's 'Oliver!' in the Hafren from the 10th – 12th October this year. Rehearsals have already started, and we are now looking for some young people to join us to play the parts of **Oliver** and the **Artful Dodger** in the show, as well as members of **Fagin's Gang**.

We will be holding an 'audition day' for these parts, and are inviting anyone interested to come along. This will be held from 10am – 5pm on Sunday 16th June at Treowen School, Newtown. There is no need to prepare anything beforehand – all audition materials will be rehearsed on the day.

The playing ages for each part is as follows:

- **Oliver:** 10-12
- **The Artful Dodger:** 13-16
- **Fagin's Gang:** 10-16

Any gender is welcome to audition for these parts, however they will be played as boys.

Rehearsals are held on Wednesday and Friday evenings, so if successful, your child will need to be available to attend rehearsals on Wednesdays and Fridays between June and October. They won't need to attend both days every week – a rehearsal schedule will be available which will provide more detail. We also recognise that the rehearsal period for 'Oliver!' includes the school summer holidays, so appreciate that you may be away on holiday for some of the weeks – please let us know about any known holiday dates on the audition form so that we can work around these.

For those successful in the auditions, a membership fee and show fee will be payable to take part in 'Oliver!'. This will be a maximum of £75 in total. Payment plans can be arranged if necessary.

If your child would be interested in attending the 'audition day', please let us know by filling in the online form which is available by following this link: <https://forms.office.com/e/A4Z88antMT>. **All forms must be submitted by 9pm on Friday 14th June.**

Further information about arrangements for the 'audition day' will be sent out by email on Saturday 15th June. It is likely that those only wanting to be considered as part of Fagin's Gang will only need to attend for the morning.
