

Eisteddfod Yr Urdd Maldwyn 2024

The Eisteddfod is nearly here and I'm contacting you today with some exciting opportunities for the young people of Maldwyn during the week of the Eisteddfod.

We're looking for 6 children ages 10/11/12 years old to be a part of the ceremonies every day. It would be wonderful to get different representatives every day. They need to be available between 13:00 and 15:00 during the week, and 12:30-14:30 on Saturday. They will need to wear all black, and be available either Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday.

We are looking for 6 young people 14+ to perform the 'muses' during the main ceremonies during the week. They will need to be available every weekday between 13:00 and 15:00 and on Saturday from 2:30 till 14:30.
